With so many things to organise, it can make your settlement a little more challenging, if people can't get hold of you, and vice versa.



When the required paperwork is presented at the telephone shop to open a new pre-paid mobile account, we trust that the three steps listed below will allow you to meet the strict government requirements to purchase a mobile phone on your arrival in Australia.

#### Before you arrive:

- 1. Apply for a tax file number (TFN);
- 2. Open a bank account;
- 3. If you are able to nominate a residential address (for example, a relative etc), you can register it with the Australian Tax Office (ATO) and on bank statements.
